

## Phase 1

**All students will be expected to review their learning prior to a half termly assessment using 365, named websites and/or teacher support material.**

- Every half term students will complete one extended written task, related to their scheme of learning, produced sequentially over the given time.
- Completed work to be shown to a parent/carer to be signed off.
- All students will complete at least one hour of reading per week and continue to take AR quizzes on a regular basis. Students are also required to catch up on work missed due to absence.

## Phase 2

**All students will be expected to review their learning prior to a half termly assessment using 365, named websites and/or teacher support material.**

- Every half term a booklet of tasks will be set in English.
- Students will show their completed work to a parent/carer or teacher to be signed off.
- In addition, students will revise for exams by completing extra set tasks where necessary and using GCSE revision websites. Students are also required to catch up on work missed due to absence.

## Post 16

**Students are expected to undertake 5 hours of independent study each week. The teacher will provide guidance and direction on what to study. All students will be expected to review their learning prior to a half termly assessment using 365, named websites and/or teacher support material.**

- Students will independently research their subject by reading primary and secondary texts.
- Students will use Jstor to research literary criticism.
- Extended written tasks will be set every fortnight or when course requirements deem extra work necessary. Students are also required to catch up on work missed due to absence.
