

Phase 1

All students will be expected to consolidate their learning from every lesson and review their learning prior to a half termly assessment using 365, named websites and/or teacher support material.

There will be a variety of extended learning opportunities within each topic. The purpose is to give our students ownership, choice and variety and to check understanding. Tasks will include:

- Research
- Making an instrument
- Presentation preparation
- write a booklet about a famous musician
- Prepare a performance of your choice for the class

Each half term students need to complete one of the extended home learning tasks and they will receive feedback on this from a peer within their class.

Students are also required to catch up on work missed due to absence.

Phase 2

All students will be expected to consolidate their learning from every lesson and review their learning prior to a half termly assessment using 365, named websites and/or teacher support material.

Students are expected to be completing home practice on their instrument or voice every week, our recommendation is 30 minutes a day.

Written homework will be set every week and will focus on developing understanding of the set work and wider listening topics. Homework could include research tasks based around the two topics, writing listening questions for other members of the class, completing essay questions etc.

Students may also be asked to complete extra composition work.

Students should ensure they are consolidating their learning from lessons every week.

Students are also required to catch up on work missed due to absence.

Post 16

Students are expected to undertake 5 hours of independent study each week. The teacher will provide guidance and direction on what to study.

All students will be expected to review their learning prior to a half termly assessment using 365, named websites and/or teacher support material.

Students are expected to be completing home practice on the instrument of their choice every week, our recommendation is between 30 minutes and an hour per day.

Students will be set at least two pieces of homework every week based around unit 3, listening and appraising. This could be a wide range of tasks including:

- Research tasks
- Listening questions
- Essay plans
- Essays
- Wider listening questions
- Students are also expected to complete composition work every week.
- Weekly consolidation of learning from lessons.

Students are also required to catch up on work missed due to absence.
