



What are the motives for movement from Mexico to the United States of America?

1.	Border	A border is a real or artificial line that separates geographic areas.
2.	Location of Mexico	
3.	Push factor	Something that makes people want to leave a place. For people in Mexico they want to leave due to lack of jobs, poverty and fear of criminal gangs.
4.	Pull factor	Something that attracts people to go and live in a place. For Mexican people they want to move to the USA for a better quality of life and access to jobs.
5.	Migrant	A person who moves from one place to another, especially in order to find work or better living conditions.

Why might North and South Korea be so different?

1.	Dictatorship	A country where total authority and control is given to one leader. There are no elections
2.	Democracy	A system or Government where every eligible member of the population can vote and elect a leader.
3.	Life in South Korea	As a democracy South Koreans enjoy greater freedoms, better health, better quality of life and environmental quality.
4.	Life in North Korea	As a dictatorship people in North Korea are subject to extreme laws and a lack of freedom.

Why are Favelas been pacified?

1.	Location of Brazil	Brazil is located in South America and is the largest Country on the continent. To the Atlantic Ocean Runs along Brazils east coast.	
2.	Favela	Informal settlements found in South America (they are known as slums elsewhere).	
3.	Conditions in Favela	Conditions can be poor due to unsafe buildings, cramped conditions, open sewers and crime	
4.	Favela Barrio	This is a project to improve Favela by pacification, building new homes and schools.	

Migrant crisis

1.	Migrant routes	Migrants travel from Western Africa from countries like Nigeria, across the Sahara desert and to countries like Libya where they can cross from their coastline to Europe via the Mediterranean sea.
2.	Migrant risks	Migrant risk the extreme heat and lack of water as they cross the Sahara desert. They must also meet and work with criminal gangs. The boats used are often unsafe and many people drawn every year.
