Daly's claim that 'if God is male then male is God' and its implications for Christianity, including:

Rosemary Radford Reuther (RRR)

Catholic feminist theologian, she wanted Christianity to move away from patriarchy, the focus should be on God not male leaders.

Male warrior messiah idea was a product of its time and not who Jesus was. Therefore the 'military maleness' of God is needed; the fact he is a biological man does not matter.

God as female wisdom- wisdom or 'Sophia' is seen as female, it has been lost through the influence of patriarchy. RRR thinks we should recognise Jesus as having 'Sophia' it is highlighted in Johns Gospel. His maleness is not essential Jesus could be any gender.

Mary Daly

Radical feminist theologian thought that religion needed a full re-evaluation and reform to remove patriarchy. She wants to aim for a post-Christian spirituality. She said we cannot just replace male terms with female, that is not enough.

- Unholy Trinity: Genocide, Rape and War. Believed women are abused because of these three male elements
- Spirituality: wanted to remove God as a fixed male figure and replace it with 'being' because God is not a man. God is not an object. God is genderless.
