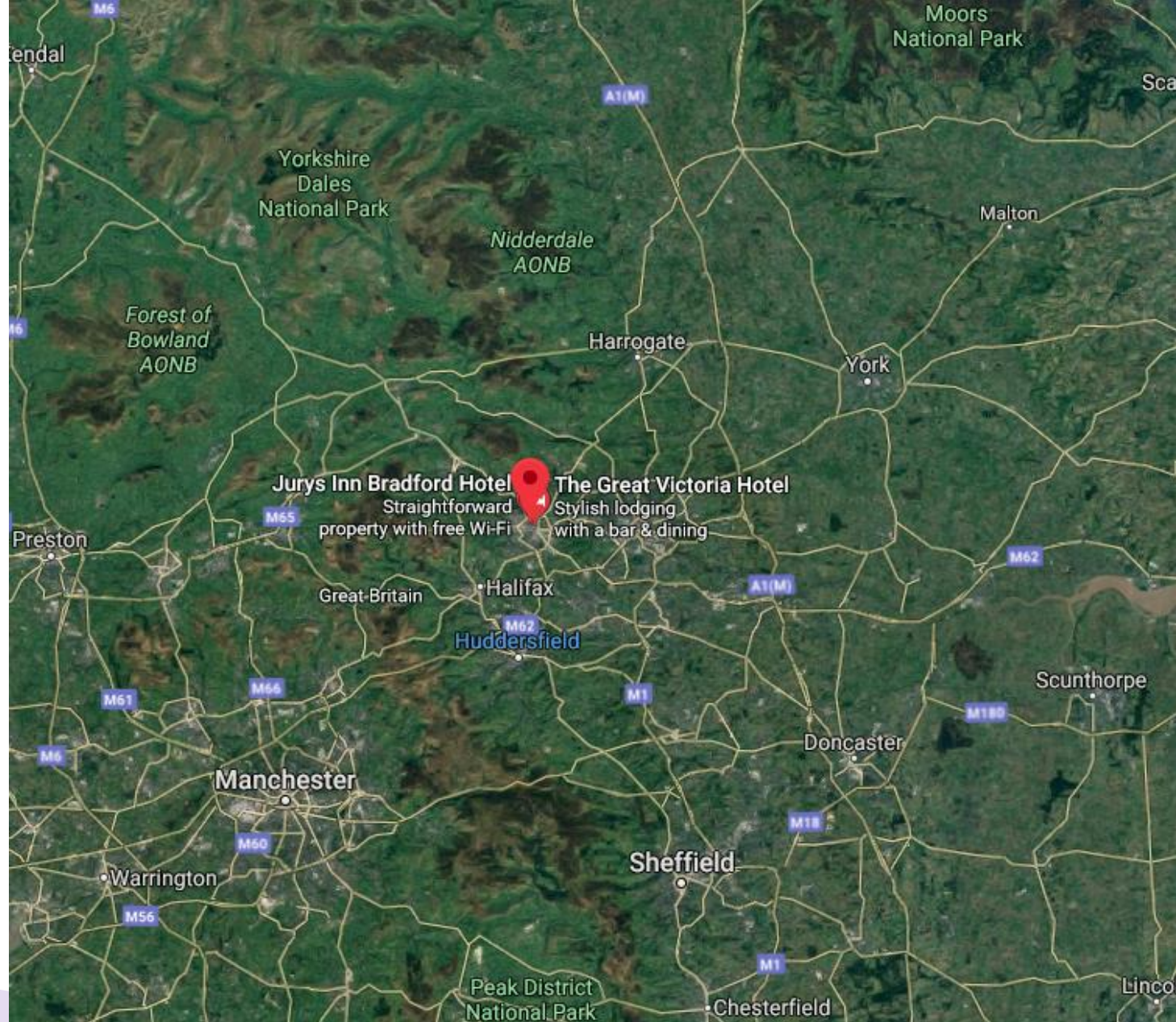

- Competition for Jobs will be intense

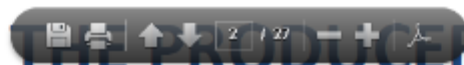

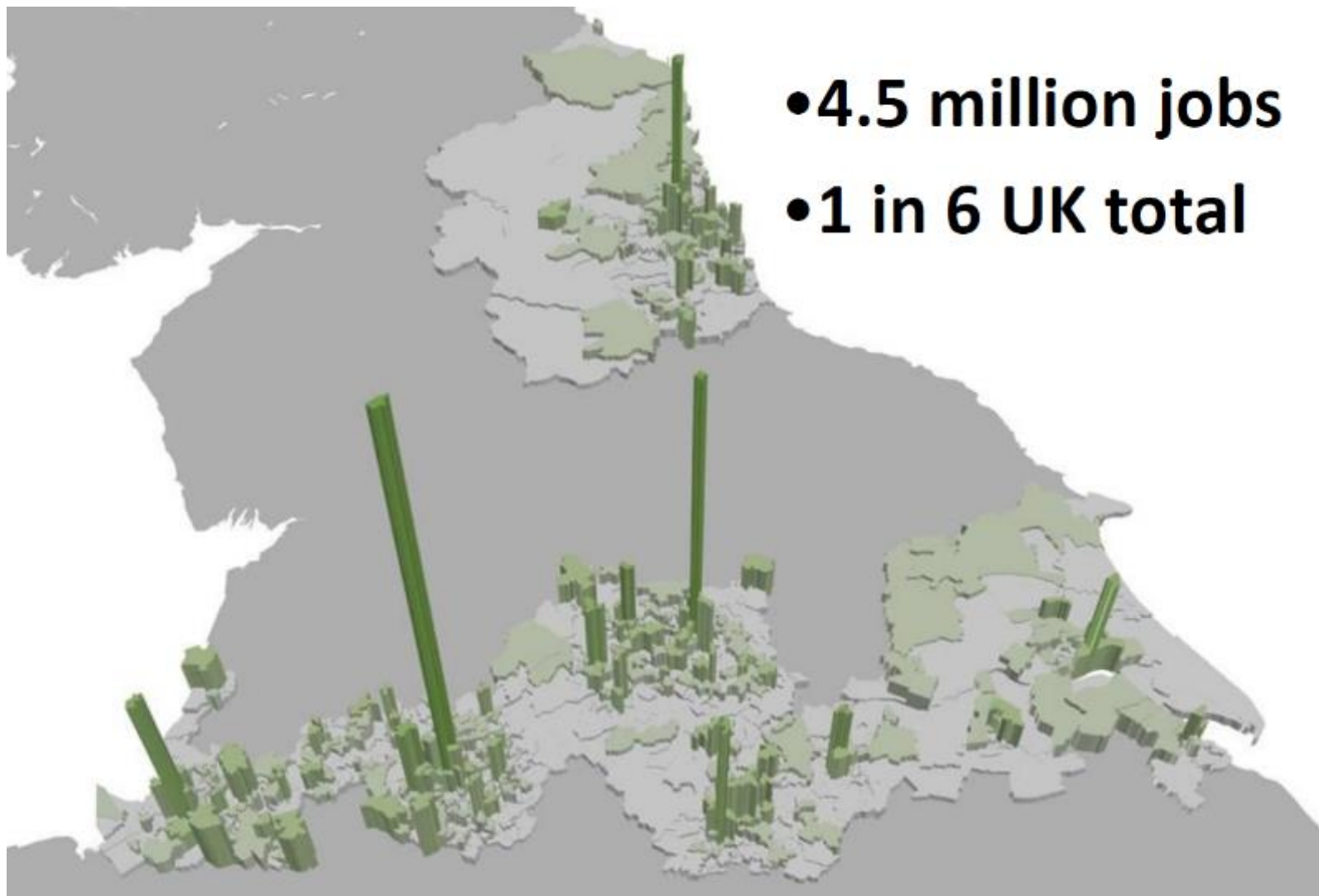

## CHALLENGES

- In 2015 we received over 4500 applications to our apprenticeship programme
  - At the first filter we “lost” over 60% of the applicants
  - In some areas we were unable to run assessment centres
- We need a skilled workforce – I need the raw materials to create it!
  - Employability skills are an important part of the mix
- Snobbery still surrounds the value of apprenticeships and vocational training
  - The UK has been “held back for too long” by outdated perceptions about apprenticeships and vocational education – Nick Clegg, 2014
- Under investment in skills is harming our productivity and the economy
  - UK GDP per hour worked is 17% lower than the G7 average
  - It’s 30% lower than the US and Germany

A key part of your study programme will be English and Maths (if you haven't already achieved a grade 4 or above).

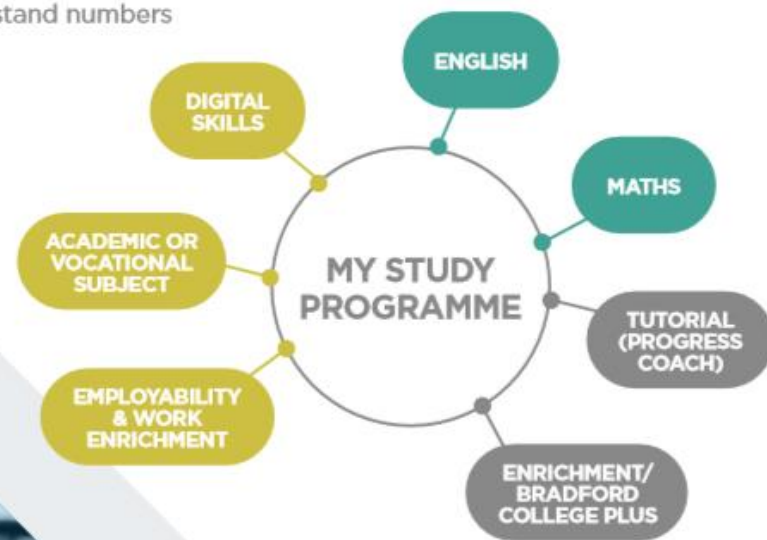

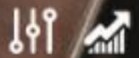

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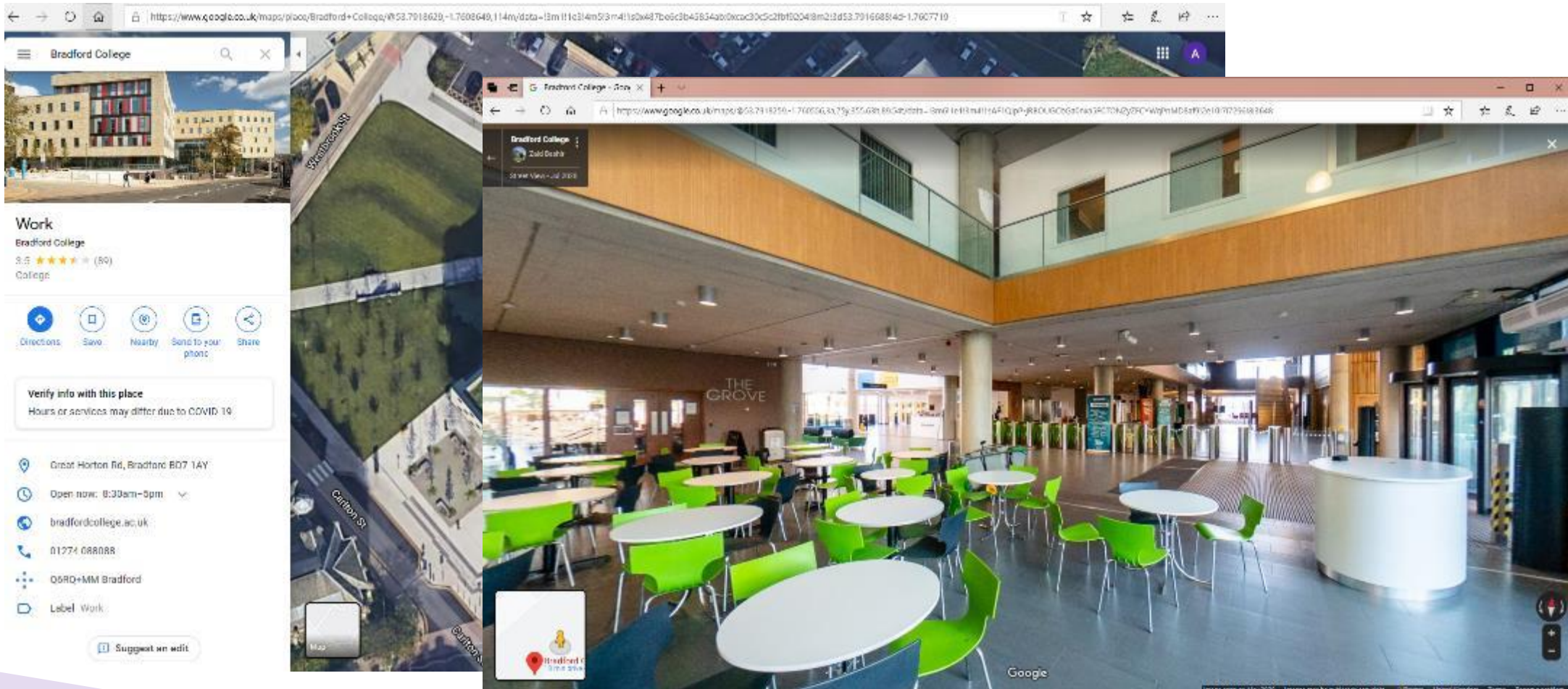
