CHALLENGES

- In 2015 we received over 4500 applications to our apprenticeship programme
 - At the first filter we "lost" over 60% of the applicants
 - In some areas we were unable to run assessment centres
- · We need a skilled workforce I need the raw materials to create it!
 - Employability skills are an important part of the mix
- · Snobbery still surrounds the value of apprenticeships and vocational training
 - The UK has been "held back for too long" by outdated perceptions about apprenticeships and vocational education – Nick Clegg, 2014
- · Under investment in skills is harming our productivity and the economy
 - UK GDP per hour worked is 17% lower than the G7 average
 - It's 30% lower than the US and Germany


English and maths skills are essential to everyday life. In all work places it's important that you can communicate effectively with co workers and colleagues and understand numbers and data.

We'll make you an offer by email and text message for a place on a course based on your GCSE grades (predicted or actual) and any other specific entry requirements.

We'll ask you to accept your offer to allocate your place on a course (you can accept multiple offers and you can change your mind once you get your results, so don't worry!).

Based on results and conditions for entry, you will be invited to enrol online during the summer (usually around GCSE results day).



Don't worry about enrolling online as we'll provide phone and in College support throughout the summer.



Following enrolment you'll officially become a Bradford College student and will be provided with a start date when you will commence your induction.


