1	Network	Connecting computers together to communicate
2	Internet	Inter connected computer networks
3	World wide web	Web pages hyperlinked to each other containing text, images, sound and video
4	Social networking	Software apps to allow groups of people to communicate with each other

How to keep safe on the Internet

1	Privacy	Only allow friends and family to view your personal data, images and videos
2	Behaviour	Understand what are acceptable and unacceptable behaviours on the internet
3	Cyberbullying	When post text or images intended to hurt, embarrass or harm a person are posted.
4	Stranger	How to identify when a person is not genuine
5	Report	Know how to report a concern on the internet

Digital Footprint

1	Websites	Your browsing history is saved on your computer, ISP and web servers.
2	Messages	The data in emails, instant messaging and MMS is saved on computers and web servers.
3	Online services	Personal data you give to online services business, government organisations and charities
4	Socialising	Data you enter on social networking sites is saved on web servers

1	Document	A file with width and height in pixels, background colour and resolution in DPI
2	Shapes	A wide variety of shapes, lines and freeform drawing pens to create images
3	Colour	Choose background, line and fill colours for all images
4	Text	Full range of fonts and sizes for text in images
