Subject Specific Criteria:

- Level 2 Pass BTEC Performing Arts or Grade 4 GCSE Drama. Students with extensive Performing Arts experience will also be considered.

Units Studied:

- Theatre Workshop
- Text in Action
- Text in Performance

Course Information:

Students will explore the role of performers, directors and designer, taking part in a variety of scripted group performances in contrasting styles. They will also research theatre companies and practitioners to devise their own performances.

Assessment is in the form of performances, creative logs and essays.

Skills Required:

- Practical performance skills
- Leadership skills
- Research skills

Futures:

Once students have gained an A level in Drama and Theatre, they may further continue their studies at Drama School or University, as well as supporting students who choose to progress directly to employment.

Subject Enrichment:

Students will perform at a range of events to invited audiences and view a variety of live professional theatre. They will have the opportunity to take part in workshops with a professional theatre practitioner in the industry.
