3. To ensure our futures programme inspires learners to be confident communicators and that we prepare them to become future-ready young people

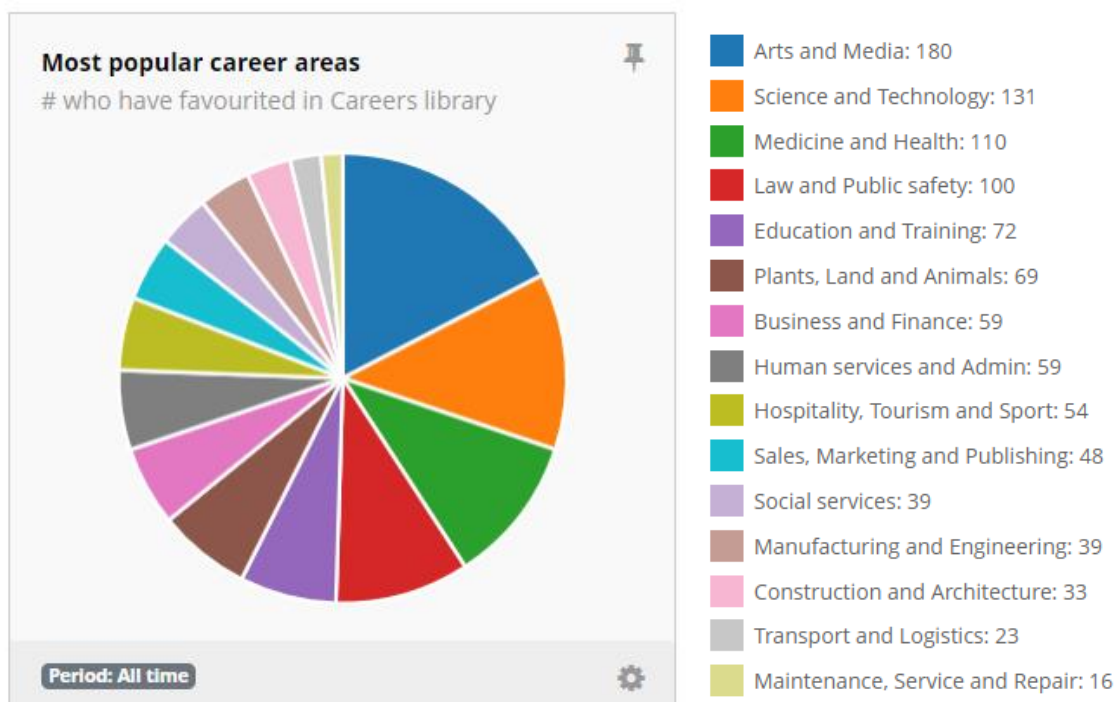

This is what we found out about our students:

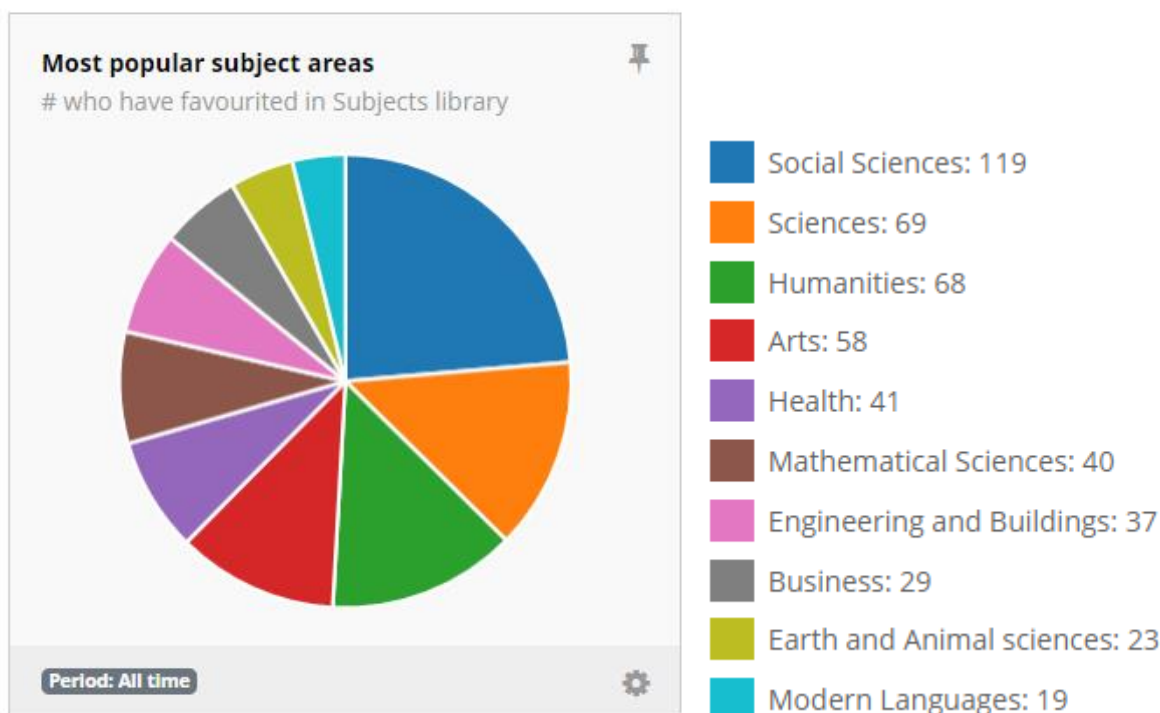
Most Popular Careers



The most popular career choice amongst our students is currently in the arts and media sector followed by science and technology then medicine and health. Law and public safety also features high on the list.

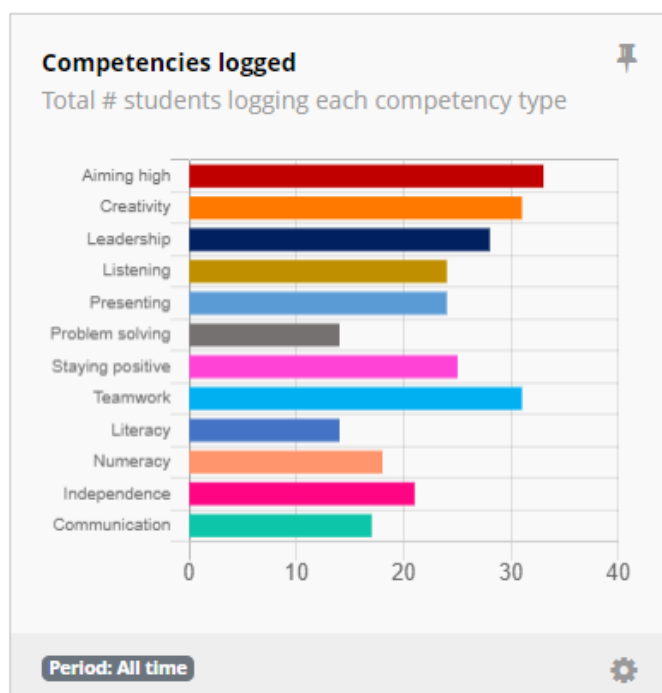
Which career area is your child interested in?

Most Popular Subject Areas



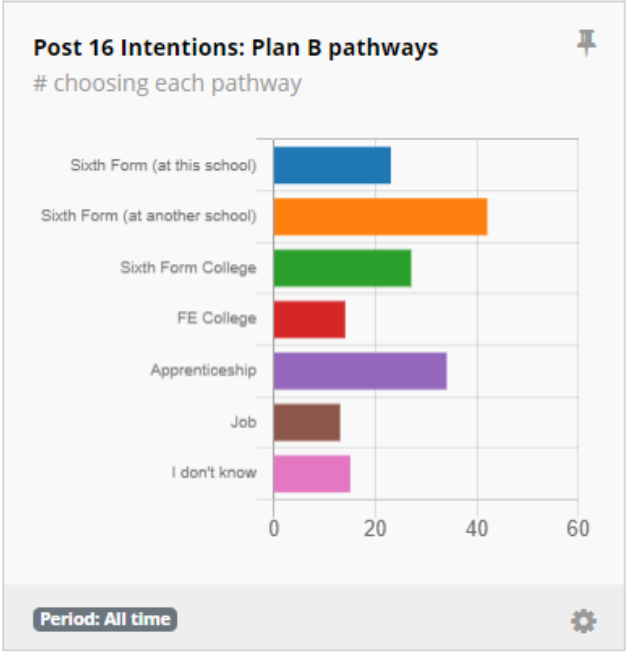
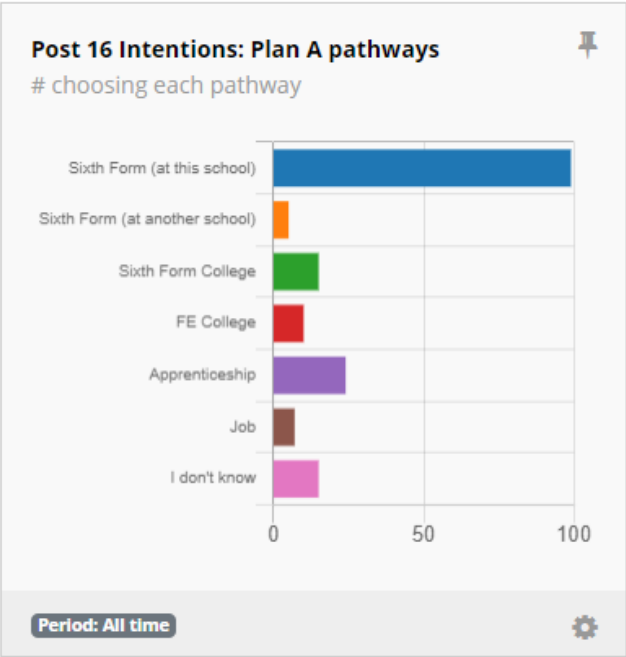
The most popular subject area is social sciences, followed by the sciences, humanities and arts. What is your child's favourite subject?

Competencies Logged



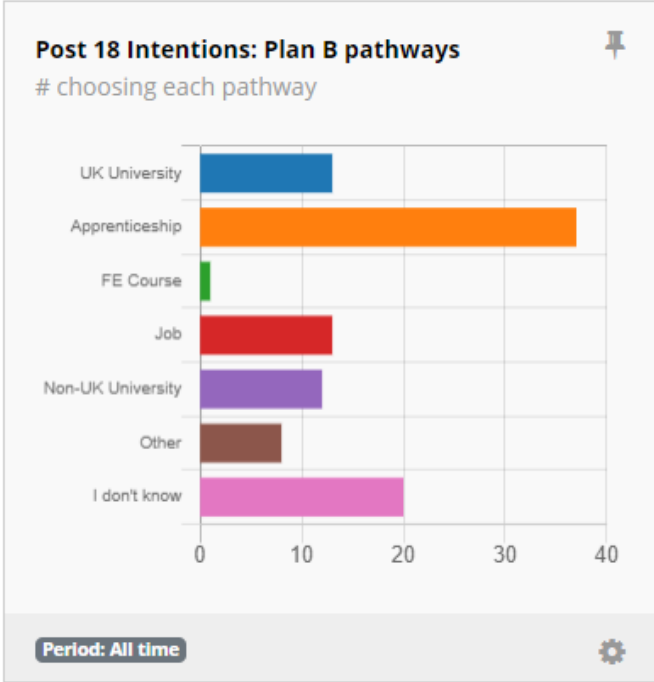
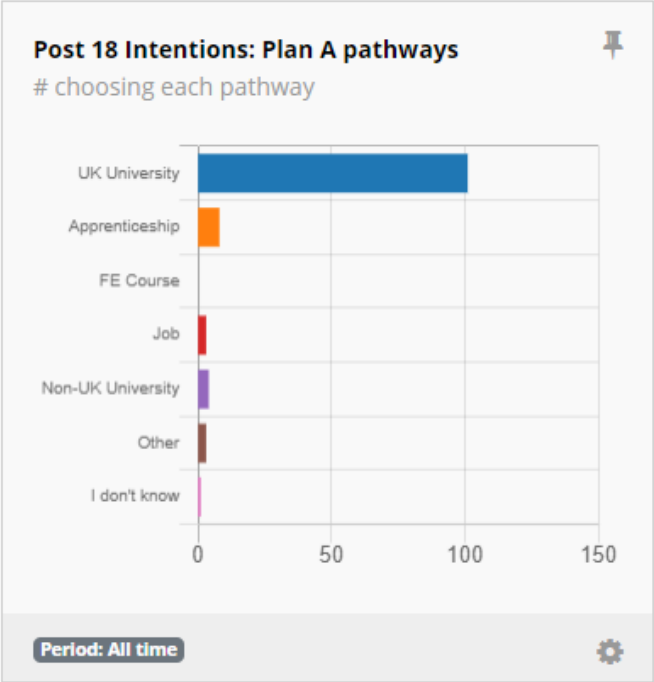
Students were confident to aim high, express creativity and show teamwork. They were less confident with problem solving and creativity. How does your child feel about the competencies above?


