The Château



The Château de la Baudonnière was founded in 1991 and is situated in the region of La Manche in Normandy.

The essence of the Château is about French language immersion. Everything at the Château involves using practical spoken French and the children are encouraged to speak French to get what they want.

From breakfast all the way to evening activities, the students are immersed in a friendly French environment thanks to the language itself, the food, the staff, the local culture and the general atmosphere of Normandy!

The Château





The Château is situated in Normandy just at the base of the Cherbourg peninsula about 6 kms north of the Cathedral city of Avranches. It is in a small countryside village called "Les Chambres" which is near "La Haye-Pesnel".









The Château



All the staff are trained in ALL the activities and only allowed to run their own sessions once they have completed their full training.

Upon arrival, the staff run a tour of the property in order to inform students of the boundaries and rules at the Château and finish with a full fire drill.

COVID and travel



- The ferry company are refusing entry onto the ferry for people who cannot prove that...
- ...they are double vaccinated

OR

- ..that they can show a negative PCR test.
- WE WILL REQUIRE PROOF OF VACCINATION OR A NEGATIVE PCR TEST TO BOARD THE COACH.
- Students who cannot do this will not be allowed board the coach.



COVID and travel



- Forms will be sent out next week to find out if students are double jabbed or if you intend to PCR test your child.
- Proof of double jabbed status will be collected at school before the Friday 15th July.
- If you intend to PCR test your child, Beckfoot will authorize a morning OR afternoon off school on Thursday 14th July to be tested
- We will need to see proof of negative status on Friday 15th July.
- Unfortunately, students that cannot prove double jabbed status OR a negative PCR test will not be allowed to attend the trip.



Château Accommodation







Specifically designed for school groups, all the accommodation blocks consist of bunk-bedded rooms with a teacher's room close-by for supervision. Each school has their own block, with boys and girls on separate floors when possible. All blocks have either en-suite rooms or communal bathrooms.





Food



The food at the Château is a full part of the French experience thanks to our great kitchen team.

With years of experience, they have developed a menu which, as well as being adapted to children's tastes, is also a real French culinary discovery. Meals are presented in French, so the students never miss a chance to learn new words.

Activities







Sessions are conducted in French according to age and level. It starts with a 15 min *Workbook* session introducing vocabulary, grammar and instructions relevant to the activity. The language introduced is then practised in a fun way during the activity and consolidated by our animateurs at the end of the session, again with the Workbook.









Evening Entertainment







All evening entertainment is organised and run by the animateurs at the Château.

Evening entertainment may include French Night (French quiz, fancy dress and snail tasting!), film night, initiative exercises, it's a knockout, treasure hunt, campfire...

What to bring



- Suitcase not too heavy to carry!
- PASSPORT AND EHIC CARD check these are in date! (Staff will keep these)
- Clothes sensible/comfortable, a few old clothes for <u>muddy activities</u>
- an old pair of trainers they WILL get muddy!
- Shoes/trainers suitable for walking
- Toiletries (spare hair bobbles if used)
- Swimwear, towel, (baseball cap or hat) sun cream
- Personal medication inhalers etc.
- Waterproof jacket
- Hand luggage rucksack + large plastic bag
- Healthy food and drinks for journey. Optional extra bottles of water
- Coach entertainment.
- Money –Pupils are responsible for their own money!
- Small pillow / ear plugs / chargers and adaptor plugs
- Pencil case.
- Charger for mobile phone/devices if appropriate / power pack if desired.
