- Do these 5 steps, and you'll have a great time!



### Activities











# What to bring



- Luggage not too heavy to carry! BECKFOOT HOODIE
- PASSPORT AND EHIC CARD check these are in date! (Staff will keep these)
- Clothes sensible/comfortable, a few old clothes for <u>muddy activities</u>
- an old pair of trainers they WILL get muddy!
- Shoes/trainers suitable for walking
- Toiletries (spare hair bobbles if used)
- Swimwear, towel, (baseball cap or hat) sun cream
- Personal medication inhalers etc.
- Waterproof jacket
- Hand luggage rucksack + large plastic bag
- Healthy food and drinks for journey. Optional extra bottles of water
- Coach entertainment.
- Money Pupils are responsible for their own money!
- Small pillow / ear plugs / chargers and adaptor plugs
- Pencil case.
- Charger for mobile phone/devices if appropriate / power pack if desired.



### Medication



Please fill out a <u>medical consent form</u> to allow your child taking any necessary or desired medication.

Staff <u>cannot provide</u> paracetamol, antihistamines etc. We can administer these only if provided to us and the form is completed

If you wish your child to have ANY medication whilst in school care, a form needs filling in prior to the trip and you will need to bring that medication with you.

Medication needs to be in original packaging and clearly labelled with your child's name.

ASTHMATIC? EPIPEN user? Please bring a spare inhaler / EPIPEN in addition to the one that you carry with you normally to hand to staff.















- You will need EITHER packed food for breakfast & lunch on the journey TO the Château or money to purchase food.
- You will need to bring money for evening meal on the ferry. The Château are providing breakfast and a packed lunch that day.
- PLEASE keep money for evening meal on return journey separate to any spending money for the trip.



## Expectations



This is an <u>educational school trip</u>, therefore the same behaviour is expected of you out of school as it is in school. Remember you are representing yourselves, the staff and Beckfoot itself.

- No smoking / e-cigarettes
- No alcohol
- Rooms need to be kept tidy and clean
- Château respect the premises
