- Expectations of students are higher, as we're out of our comfort zones and with the general public – represent yourselves well at all times.








Represent well

Expectations



- Listen- If we give you an instruction you need to follow it

- **Be helpful-** Each of you will be assigned a Job. Help others if they need it, help staff, try not to stand around doing nothing, if we all help it will make things much easier and smoother

What to bring



There is a guide list of key things in the booklet, we haven't added obvious things – like clothes!

- Pack Light- 1 suitcase / holdall plus 1 Small bag for travel
- You will need to bring your own towel as the hostel don't provide them.
- Don't forget your instrument! It has happened before.



Valuables



- Valuables and personal items are your responsibility
- We will not be able to replace personal items if they are lost or stolen
- Don't bring anything you can't replace
- Instruments are insured up to the value of £750 through the tour company – they might be covered by house insurance – please do check.



Money



- Food is included- breakfast, packed lunch and evening meal
- You might want to bring money to get some snacks when we are out and about, and for the journey.
- Don't bring too much cash
 (€100 and £30 should be enough)



Medication

Please fill out a medical consent form to allow your child taking any necessary or desired medication.

Staff <u>cannot provide</u> paracetamol, antihistamines etc. We can administer these, but only if provided to us and the form is completed

If you wish your child to have ANY medication whilst in school care, a form needs filling in prior to the trip and you will need to bring that medication with you.

Medication needs to be in original packaging and clearly labelled with your child's name.

ASTHMATIC? EPIPEN user? Please bring a spare inhaler / EPIPEN in addition to the one that you carry with you normally to hand to staff.
