Paper 2 – Writers’ Viewpoints and Perspectives

Section A: Modern Texts (30 marks Plus 4 SPAG marks) 45 mins

You will answer one question from a choice of two on *An Inspector Calls*.

Section B: Power and Conflict Poetry (30 marks) 45 mins

You will answer one comparative question on one named poem printed on the paper and one other poem from the anthology.

Section C: Unseen poetry (32 marks) 45 mins

You will answer one question on one unseen poem (24 marks) 30 mins
and one question comparing this poem with a second unseen poem (8 marks) 15 mins

How to revise

You will not be allowed copies of the texts in the exams. You will need to learn key quotations from each text as part of your revision. Some active ways to revise include:

- Make flash cards
- Make mind maps
- Look up past papers on AQA and plan answers or write them out in full against the clock
- Use Seneca to help you revise and to test your knowledge
- Use online revision sources such as BBC Bitesize, Mr Bruff and Quizlet. Actively use them by adding to your mind maps or notes.
- Talk about the texts with your friends and family – try to explain the core meaning for each one.
