### 1. Mind-maps



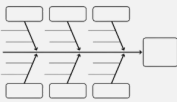
Branch of subtopics from the main topic in the middle of the page.

### 2. Time-lines



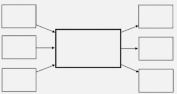
order events using a timeline

Understand the AQA exam command words

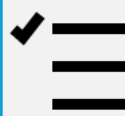
