4. Exam-style Questions

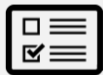


Attempted the quizzes based on GCSE geography past papers. There are 50 exam-style questions and each activity contains ten questions.

1. Self-quiz

2. Flash cards

3. Paired retrieval



Give your KO to a friend or family member. Ask them to quiz you and check your understanding.

4. RAG knowledge

1. Make links



Can you think like a geographer and make links between each topic?
Create a mind map or concept map.

2. Processes



Can you write in sequence?
Create a visual flow diagram to show the formation of geographical landforms.

3. Examples



Do you know your case studies?
Graphic organisers are a good way to summarise the details. Use a Venn diagram to compare tectonic case studies.

4. Taboo



Can you define keywords or ideas based on visual or verbal clues?
Create a game of taboo and play with a partner.



Using past papers

1. Time



Set time to practice improving your knowledge or geographical skills, using past papers. Practice in timed conditions.

2. Plan



Plan longer answers (6/9 marks)
Check your plan against the mark scheme. attempt to answer the question.

3. Use model answers



Use model answers/ mark-schemes to pull apart and identify the key parts. Then answer a similar question and try to replicate.

4. Command words
