What is enrichment week?

- During Enrichment Week, normal timetabled lessons will be suspended. Instead, a variety of activities and trips will be organised by members
- These activities will develop cross-curricular themes and dimensions and give students an opportunity to enjoy a wealth fun of experiences beyond the curriculum, which may ignite a passion of theirs or push them beyond their comfort zone.

Activities and Trips on offer:

- The activities and trips are outlined in this booklet.
- Students should read through these with their parent/carer and decide on their choice together.
- If no choices are made, your child will be allocated to an activity based on availability.
- To avoid disappointment, it is important to meet the deadlines.

Choosing your activity:

- When students have decided which activity they would most like to take part in, they must complete their choices on the form provided.

- Please note that allocations will be based on a first come, first serve basis.
- Please make three different choices. The second and third choice being reserves in case their first choice is already full or does not run due to limited uptake.
- Please complete the form no later than Sunday 10 November 2024 at 6:00pm. Any replies submitted after the deadline may result in the student not being allocated any of their chosen activities.
- Please do not send any money at this stage. All payments must be made via ParentPay and the first deposit is due on Friday 29 November 2024.

Confirmation of Trip Place and Payments:

Once your child has been allocated a place, a payment schedule will appear on your ParentPay account and you will be able to start paying for the activity.

Importance of Exceptional Behaviour and Attendance:

Commitment to a trip and non-refundable deposits:

- Parents/Carers are required to complete the form on behalf of the student.
- Once students choose their activities they have committed to that activity. There will be no swapping at later dates.
- All activities are non refundable from first payment including deposits regardless of circumstance.
- will have already made commitments/deposit, in order to secure the bookings for accommodation, transport, insurance and activities as with any other trip booking.
- Once they have been been allocated, students cannot make changes to their choice.
- Confirmation of your child's allocated place will be sent to you 20 November 2024.
- The safety of our students is paramount on all activities, and unless we are advised not to travel by the Home or Foreign Office, then the trip will still go ahead. As a result deposits and all payments are non-refundable regardless of changes to personal, local, national or international circumstances.
- As a result it is crucial that parents/carers think carefully before committing to an activity, especially residential
- We reserve the right to cancel trips if take-up is low. In this circumstance only, deposits will be refunded.

- We make every effort to ensure that students have a wide range of activities to choose from, that all curriculum areas are covered and that all budgets are catered for.
- These costs cover materials, accommodation, transport and admission fees depending on the activity.
- We hope all parents/carers will be able to support us in this exciting week, which is a great opportunity to extend our students' experiences beyond the normal curriculum.
- It is important that parents keep up to date with the payment schedule as these coincide with the payments school will be making to travel companies.
- Missed payments (unless contact is made with the school) will be considered as non-commitment to the activity and will result in loss of place and all previous
- We will endeavour to provide the activities as described specifically in this booklet but occasionally this may have to change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- If student numbers for a trip are slightly lower than expected, the cost may increase.

Pupil Premium:

- Please be aware that Pupil Premium funding will not be used to subsidise Enrichment Week trips (see the Pupil Premium policy on the school website).
- Please take into consideration the cost of trip/activity when making your choice.

- It is vital that we have up to date information on your child's medical requirements including prescribed drugs.
- All prescribed and non-prescribed medication (including paracetamol) will need to be handed in to trip leaders with clear instructions on their administration.
- We will need a completed medical form submitted to school no later than 4 June 2025 please look out for further communication on how to access these.
